

Wolfpack One Card

The Wolfpack One Card is the official ID card for the university. It enables students to:

- Access meal plans
- Enter their residence hall or other buildings with restricted access
- Work out at the gym
- Check out books at the library
- Create and access their AllCampus account to make purchases at participating on-campus locations. All Campus funds are also used for Wolfprint (campus air printers). Wolfprint provides quick and easy printing at a variety of buildings across campus.

As an incoming student attending orientation, you will present a picture ID (valid driver's license, state ID card, military ID, or passport), have your photo taken, and receive your One Card. You can upload your picture before orientation online in the GET (<https://photo.onecard.ncsu.edu/#/new-photo>) portal. Students unable to attend orientation can come to our office during our business hours to receive their One Card.

Students are encouraged to store their card in a safe and convenient location as they will use it often during the course of a day. Don't expose the card to the heat of a dryer or wireless charging pads to extend the life of the card. Replacement cards are \$20.

To report a lost or stolen card, visit the Wolfpack One Card office or go online (<http://onecard.ncsu.edu/>). The office is located on the main level of Talley Student Union. Students can also stop by to ask questions about the many features of the ID card during regular business hours: Monday - Friday from 8 a.m. - 5 p.m.
