

# Spanish (Certificate)

A four-semester program of study in Spanish as an additional language to allow undergraduate students to develop competence in and knowledge of the Spanish language, increased understanding and appreciation of Spanish and Hispanic cultures and greater knowledge of the countries where Spanish is spoken. This program is open to undergraduates in any major and of any class standing.

## Plan Requirements

- A total of 12 semester hours is required; at least six credit hours must be taken at NC State. The remaining credit hours may be taken through affiliate programs (e.g. the UNC Language Exchange ([https://fill.chass.ncsu.edu/undergraduate/language\\_exchange.php](https://fill.chass.ncsu.edu/undergraduate/language_exchange.php)) or an NC State Study Abroad program).
